RESOLUTION NO. 1110-2020

**DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 5 FOR
CALENDAR YEAR 2020 OF MANGALDAN, PANGASINAN
INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P15,293,532.67
OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 5 for Calendar Year 2020 involving total appropriations of **P15,293,532.67** which was approved on October 23, 2020 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2020-08;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted preliminary review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. The funding sources for the subject Supplemental Budget were determined in accordance with Section 321 of RA 7160 and Article 417 (a) of its IRR, as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;
2. The additional appropriation for payment of service vehicle (van) shall be in accordance with the provisions of Administrative Order No. 14, S-2018, as implemented under Budget Circular No. 2019-2 dated March 4, 2019, amending Administrative Order No. 15 dated May 2015, 2011 and Budget Circular No. 2017-1 dated April 26, 2017 amending Budget Circular No. 2016-5 dated August 22, 2016;

3. All programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and FY 2020 Annual/Supplemental Investment Program of the municipality formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, S-2007 dated 08 March 2007; and
4. All procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of RA No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.


WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality and shall notify the offices concerned of the actions taken thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Jeremy Agerico B. Rosario and Liberato Z. Villegas and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia and Jerome Vic O. Espino, duly seconded, it was –

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare **OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY the Supplemental Budget No. 5 for Calendar Year 2020 of Mangaldan, Pangasinan** as of the date fixed therein for its effectivity; provided, that the disbursement of appropriations as approved shall be subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations, and compliance with other pertinent laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Mangaldan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
