RESOLUTION NO. 133-2020

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 45, S-2019 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MAPANDAN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM FY-2020 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MAPANDAN, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Mapandan, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 45, Series of 2019 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the same is in consonance to Sections 106, 109, 114 of RA 7160. The Municipal Development Council of Mapandan, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for FY 2020. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan thru MDC Resolution No. 03, S-2019 dated September 25, 2019 and was favorably acted upon by the Sangguniang Bayan on October 28, 2018 thru SB Resolution No. 45, S-2019;

WHEREAS, the Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1, S-2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Mapandan, Pangasinan was prepared using the prescribed AIP Summary Form, and covers: a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the different offices broken down into: Personal Services (PS),



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Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, b) the priority development programs/projects of the LGU including those to be funded by the 20% development fund, c) Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Programs/Projects/Activities, and d) Activities in pursuance of the objectives of GAD of the LGU. Also attached to the AIP, among others, are the following: a) Peace and Order Plan, b) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, c) List of Programs/Projects/Activities for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability, d) Nutrition and Protection Program for Children, and e) Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council Action Plan;

WHEREAS, the AIP of Mapandan for CY 2020 has an investment requirement of P122,402,454.00, will be financed by the LGU as embodied in their 2020 Annual Budget passed and approved by the Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 02, S-2019 dated October 28, 2019. Their AIP also includes medium/long term projects for funding by the LGUs, NGOs, and NGAs sources;

WHEREAS, said AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGUs IRA (P108,790,704.00) which is equivalent to P21,758,140.80 is allocated for development projects;

WHEREAS, the development projects proposed to be funded by the 20% development fund were based on the DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2017-1, dated February 22, 2017 entitled "Updated Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects";

WHEREAS, the programs and projects included in the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Investment Plan amounting to P5,843,122.70, were based on Section 21 of RA 10121 and NDRMMC, DBM & DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund). **However, the DRRM Plan shall be submitted by the municipality to the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) for review as provided under Item No. 2.2.12 of the Department of Budget and Management as per Local Budget Memorandum No. 77 dated May 15, 2018;**

WHEREAS, the Gender and Development Plan and Budget for FY 2020 of the LGU has been reviewed and approved by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Provincial Office, and were found to be fully compliant in form and in contents with the provisions of the DBM, PCW, DILG & NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2016-01 entitled "Amendments to JMC 2013-01 or the Guidelines on the Localization of Magna Carta of Women";

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order;



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WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Vici M. Ventanilla and Angel M. Baniqued, Jr. and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jose G. Peralta, Jr., duly seconded, it was –


RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 45, S-2019 of the Sangguniang Bayan of **Mapandan**, Pangasinan, entitled “Approving the Annual Investment Program Fy-2020 of the Municipality of Mapandan, Pangasinan”;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Mapandan, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
