### **RESOLUTION NO. 139-2019**

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 60, S-2018 OF THE **SANGGUNIANG BAYAN** OF SAN **OUINTIN,** PANGASINAN, **ENTITLED** "APPROVING THE PROGRAMS, PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN (AIP) **OF** MUNICIPAL ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CY 2019 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN QUINTIN, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of San Quintin, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 60, Series of 2018 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the Local Development Council of San Quintin, Pangasinan has formulated the municipality's Annual Investment Program for CY 2019 and endorsed thru MDC Resolution No. 2, S-2018 dated August 16, 2018 to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval. This was subsequently approved by their Sangguniang Bayan thru Resolution No. 60, S-2018 dated October 15, 2018. This is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of RA 7160;





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
> WHEREAS, the Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1, S-2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of San Quintin, Pangasinan was formulated following the prescribed AIP Summary Form, and covers: a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the different municipal offices broken down into: Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, b) the priority development programs/projects of the LGU including those to be funded by the 20% development fund, c) Disaster Risk Reduction Management Programs/Projects/Activities of the municipality. It also includes as an integral part the following: 1) Gender and Development Plan, Peace and Order Plan, Local Climate Change Action Plan and 2) list of programs/projects for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities and to combat HIV-AIDS;

> WHEREAS, the AIP has a total investment requirement amounting to P130,144,104.17. Of this, P119,006,104.17 will be funded from the municipality's proposed 2019 Annual Budget which was passed and approved by their Sangguniang Bayan on November 5, 2018 through Appropriation Ordinance Nos. 6 (General Fund) and 7 (Local Economic Enterprise), both S-2018. The remaining amount of P11,138,000.00 will be funded by the National Government Agencies under Assistance to Municipalities Program;

**WHEREAS,** the development fund amounting to P21,500,000.00 which is allocated for development projects is 20% of the municipality's IRA (P106,316,710.00) for CY 2019. This is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160;

WHEREAS, the identified development programs/projects to be funded by the 20% of IRA were based on the DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2017-1, dated February 22, 2017 entitled "Updated Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects";

WHEREAS, likewise, the programs, projects and activities of the 5% LDRRM Fund of the municipality amounting to P5,948,335.50 conforms with Section 21 of RA 10121 and NDRMMC, DBM & DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund);





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**WHEREAS**, the LGU has also identified programs, projects and activities responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015;

WHEREAS, the Gender and Development Plan of the municipality was already reviewed by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and found fully compliant in form and contents with the provisions of the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2016-01: Amendments to JMC 2013-01 re: Guidelines on the Localization of Magna Carta of Women as per attached Certificate of Review and Endorsement of the DILG;

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Salvador S. Perez, Jr. and Noel C. Bince and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Arth Bryan C. Celeste, duly seconded, it was –

**RESOLVED**, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 60, S-2018 of the Sangguniang Bayan of **San Quintin**, Pangasinan, entitled "Approving the programs, projects and activities of the Annual Investment Plan (AIP) of the Municipal Annual Budget for CY 2019 of the Municipality of San Quintin, Pangasinan";
