WINNING THE 53RD QubicaAMF BOWLING WORLD CUP
CHAMPIONSHIP 2017 HELD IN HERMOSILLO, MEXICO
LAST NOVEMBER 11, 2017**

WHEREAS, the QubicaAMF Bowling World Cup, formerly known as the International Masters and AMF Bowling World Cup, is an annual Ten-pin bowling championship sponsored by QubicaAMF Worldwide, and the largest in bowling in terms of number of participating countries;

WHEREAS, last year, Krizziah Lyn B. Tabora, a 26-year old native daughter of Alcala, Pangasinan, has ably represented the Philippines and brought the glory back to her countrymen as she was crowned the Champion in the Women's Division;
