RESOLUTION NO. 324-2022

DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2021-07 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BUGALLON, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE CREATING TWENTY EIGHT NEW POSITIONS, ABOLISHING TWO VACANT POSITIONS AND TRANSFERRING TWO POSITIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BUGALLON, PANGASINAN” AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bugallon, Pangasinan submitted its Municipal Ordinance No. 2021-07 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province have conducted initial review and study on said municipal ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Sections 76, 447 (a) (1) (viii) of R.A. 
