RESOLUTION NO. 346-2022

DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 2, S-2022 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SAN QUINTIN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF TWO (2) PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE III, SALARY GRADE 17 IN THE OFFICE OF RURAL HEALTH UNIT (RHU) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN QUINTIN, PANGASINAN" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of San Quintin, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 2, S-2022 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province have conducted initial review and study on said municipal ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Sections 76, 447 (a) (1) (viii) of R.A. No. 7160;

WHEREAS, the qualifications of the new positions should be included in the ordinance. Further, the position title of Public Health Nurse II, Salary Grade 17 should be changed to Nurse III to conform with the Index of Occupational Services (Position Titles and Salary Grades in the Local Government/IOS-LGU, CY 2021 Edition, under Local Budget Circular No. 137 dated July 13, 2021);
