**RESOLUTION NO. 422-2019**

**APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 016-2019 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LABRADOR, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LABRADOR, PANGASINAN FOR CY 2019"**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Labrador, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 016-2019 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the same is in consonance to Sections 106, 109, 114 of RA 7160. The Local Development Council of Labrador, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for CY 2019. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan thru MDC Resolution No. 003, S-2018 dated December 15, 2018 and was favorably acted upon by the Sangguniang Bayan on May 6, 2019 thru SB Resolution No. 016-2019;

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1, S-2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG





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JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Labrador, Pangasinan was prepared using the prescribed AIP Summary Form, and covers: a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the different offices broken down into: Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, b) the priority development programs/projects of the LGU including those to be funded by the 20% development fund, c) Gender and Development, Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Programs/Projects/Activities, Local Council for the Protection of Children, Programs for Senior Citizens, Peace and Order Plan and Programs/Projects/Activities to Combat AIDS;

**WHEREAS**, the AIP of Labrador for CY 2019 has a total investment requirement of P95,897,489.00. Funding support for the implementation of which is embodied in their 2019 Annual Budget passed and approved by the Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, S-2019 dated May 6, 2019 and was approved by the Municipal Mayor on May 16, 2019;

**WHEREAS**, said AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGUs IRA (P86,373,039.00) which is equivalent to P17,274,607.80 is allocated for development projects. The development projects proposed to be funded by the 20% development fund were based on the DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2017-1, dated February 22, 2017 entitled "Updated Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects";

**WHEREAS**, the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management programs, projects and activities in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund amounting to P4,794,874.45 are in accordance to Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs, projects and activities to be funded by 7% of the 5% LDRRM Fund in the amount of P3,356,412.12 were based on Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 of the NDRMMC, DBM & DILG dated March 25, 2013 (Joint Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund);

**WHEREAS**, the LGU of Labrador has also identified programs, projects and activities responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015;

**WHEREAS**, the Gender and Development Programs, Projects and Activities (GAD-PPAs) attached were reviewed by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Provincial Office, and were found to be fully compliant in form and in contents with the provisions of the DBM, PCW, DILG & NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2016-01 entitled "Amendments to JMC 2013-01 or the Guidelines on the Localization of Magna Carta of Women";



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**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Nestor D. Reyes and Von Mark R. Mendoza and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jose G. Peralta, Jr., duly seconded, it was –


**RESOLVED**, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 016-2019 of the Sangguniang Bayan of **Labrador**, Pangasinan, entitled “Approving the Annual Investment Program of the Municipality of Labrador, Pangasinan for CY 2019”;
