RESOLUTION NO. 540-2021

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 3 FOR CY 2021 OF MANGALDAN, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P32,184,000.00 OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 3 for Calendar Year 2021 involving total appropriations of P 32,184,000.00 which was approved on May 21, 2021 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2021-06;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of Local Finance Committee pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted preliminary review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. That the funding sources of the subject Supplemental Budget were determined in accordance to Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160 and Article 414 (a) of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;
2. That the appropriations for Monetization of Leave Credits shall be subject to the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2016-2 dated March 29, 2026 re: Computation and Funding of Terminal Leave Benefits and Monetization of Leave Credits which provide for the new constant factor stated under Item 3.1 thereof;



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3. That all procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its implementing rules and regulations;

4. That all programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and the FY 2021 Annual/Supplemental Investment Program of the municipality formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2017, dated March 8, 2007;

5. That the purchase of motor vehicle/s shall be in accordance with the provisions of DILGF Memorandum Circular No. 2021-04 dated January 18, 2021;

6. That the appropriation for payment of electricity (2007-2012) shall be subject to Section 350 of R.A. No. 7160;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;

NOW THEREFOR, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Jeremy Agerico B. Rosario and Liberato Z. Villegas and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan, duly seconded, it was –

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Operative In Its Entirety the Supplemental Budget No. 03 for Calendar Year 2021 of Mangaldan, Pangasinan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
