RESOLUTION NO. 554-2022

APPROVING SB RESOLUTION NO. 01-2022 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MANAOAG, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE 1st SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MANAOAG, PANGASINAN”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Manaoag, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 01-2022 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. The Municipal Development Council of Manaoag, Pangasinan prepared the municipality’s 1st Supplemental Investment Program for CY 2022. This was endorsed by the Council through MDC Resolution No. 01, S-2022 dated March 4, 2022 to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval;
2. Said Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) which has a total investment requirement of P11,545,412.00, covers augmentation funds for Maintenance & Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), and Capital Outlay (CO) of the LGU, to include COVID-19 related PPAs, DRRM-related projects/activities, and other development projects of the municipality; and

- Funding for the SIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 1, FY 2022 in the amount of P11,545,412.00, which was approved by the Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, S-2022 dated March 18, 2022.


WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Manaoag, Pangasinan;


